Hailing a Hero

Plane Saver Credit Union extends condolences to the family and acquaintances of Lieutenant Colonel Gary Tait MBE, who passed away on Monday, 17th June at the age of 52.

Gary was the Ministry of Defence Lead Officer for the Credit Union Joining Forces Initiative which was established in 2015 to reduce debt among service personnel. Plane Saver is one of the three credit unions selected by the MOD to provide ethical financial services under the Joining Forces brand.

In addition to his work with the Joining Forces initiative, Gary served in the Army for 36 years and was a proud member of the Royal Regiment of Scotland. During his career he held appointments at the Scottish Divisional Depot and deployed on operational tours in Northern Ireland, Bosnia, the Gulf War, Iraq and Afghanistan. The holder of an MA from Kings College London, he also worked as a director of the British Forces Broadcasting Service and chairman of the McCrae's Battalion Trust.

For his outstanding service to country, Gary was awarded an MBE in 2002, followed by The Queen's Commendation for Valuable Service in 2014. He also received the Chief of the General Staff Commendation in 2016.

Gary's devotion to helping others and his contribution to the growth of Plane Saver has left us an enduring legacy. We share the sorrow of his loved ones and colleagues at the passing of a remarkable man.
